

**Trudy Ahern SSJ**, a Sister of St. Joseph of Philadelphia, is codirector of the Upper Room Spiritual Center, Neptune, New Jersey. She trains and supervises spiritual directors, gives directed retreats, and teaches in the summer at Creighton University, Omaha, Nebraska.
